Las Corazas Macabeo (Spain) £15.00 btl £3.90gls 175ml

A Very tasty drop from La Mancha, just north of Madrid. Ultra modern, clean and fruity with fresh aromas and tones of tropical flavour.

Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) £16.85 btl, £4.60 gls 175ml

Light elegant style with citrus, green fruits and gentle acidity. Full of tingling aromatics, typical of its grape variety, this wine is bursting with tropical fruit flavours, yet retains freshness through its natural racy acidity.

Forgemill bush vine Chenin Blanc vintage 2009 (South Africa) £17.90 btl £4.75 gls.

Fresh fruit salad in a glass packed with fresh melon, pineapple and kiwi fruit aromas. Chenin heads will like it. (A lot)

Pinot grigio Ancora (Italy) £18.50, bottle £4.90gls 175ml

A fresh, dry white with gentle floral and citrus aromas. Crisp and delicate on the palate with lightly honeyed fruit balanced by lemony acidity and a fresh, dry finish.

Rioja Monte Clavijo (Spain) £19.90 btl £5.10 gls 175ml

100% Viura grapes from the Rioja region in Northern Spain; imagine a cool mountain stream that someone's dropped a pear into.

Urban Torrontes (Argentina) £22.50 btl

Brilliant expression of this unusual yet upcoming grape. Explosive aromas of rose petal and strawberry with generous lychee, pear and ginger flavours. This has good structure and body and plenty of fruit but is still dry

Fairfield's Marlborough sauvignon (New Zealand) £26.00 btl

From the famous Marlborough region - this is liquid summer in a glass with serious volumes of white peaches and nectarines!! Don't hold back- have a bottle each!

Red

Sierra Grande Merlot (Chile) £16.85 £4.60 GLS 175ML

A rich and warm red wine, deep in colour and showing ripe plum and berry fruity aroma, the palate exhibits rich fruit, soft tannins, a silky texture and plenty of weighty fruit.

Rioja Anzarena Tempranillo (Spain) £18.70 btl £4.70 gls 175ml

Delicious, ripe, plummy red with a bit of crunchy pepper and a rich, savoury finish

Marktree merlot/Cab/Shiraz (Australia) £19.30 BTL, £4.80 GLS 175ML

CLASSIC OZZIE BLEND. Very easy drinking with bags n of crunchy fruit and the merest hint of oak to smooth out the edges.

El Tesoro Malbec (Argentina) £20.50 btl £4.90 gls 175ml

Delicious red with deep dark damson jam and bramble fruit flavours, mingling with the little twist of crushed black pepper.

Urban Tempranillo (Argentina) £22.50 btl

Another gem from the forward thinking bodegas o. Fournier. Think of it as a turbo charged rioja –soft and mellow with oodles of punchy dark red fruit.

Juan Gill's Monastrell Monastrell (Spain) £25.50 btl,

So good they named it twice! Another red with bucketfuls of bright cherry flavour with notes of mocha and five spice. Brilliant stuff.

Trentham Pinot Noir (Australia) £28.90

A light, elegant style of Pinot Noir with complex summer pudding flavours and very well balanced, juicy acidity.

Rose

Las Corazas – Tempranillo Rosado (Spain) £15.00 BTL £3.90 gls 175ml

Made from Tempranillo (the grape famously used in Rioja) it is dry-but-not-too-dry with plenty of strawberry & raspberry fruit.

The Big Top, White zinfandel (USA) £20.50 btl £5.05 gls 175ml

Deliciously juicy and sweet packed with bright summer fruit. This rose makes for perfect summer drinking and afternoons gossiping amongst friends.

Champagne

Prosecco Tenuta ca' bolani (Italy) £22.50 btl

Fully sparkling prosecco. Fantastic wine with ripe peach, pear and citrus fruits. Demands to be drunk in the sunshine, immediately!

Plucked right from the heart of champagne in the village of Hautvillers. About 1861, Dom Perignon, then cellar master in the Benedictine abbey of Hautvillers, invented champagne as we know it today.
